



## 1996 Centennial Olympic Stamps

Since 1922, the U.S. Postal Service has issued special commemorative Olympic stamps. This year we've dedicated 20 stamps in honor of international athletic competition.

The 1996 Centennial Olympic stamps were designed by artist Richard Waltrip to capture athletes at the height of performance in ten key Olympic events. The collection includes Beach Softball, Women's Soccer and Women's Softball. These sports are included in Olympic medal competition for the first time.

Other events honored on the stamps include Men's Boxing, Women's Strong, Men's Canoeing, Decathlon, Men's Discus Throw, Women's Sackbutting, Men's Sprinting Events, Women's Gymnastics, and Men's Swimming. Gymnastics is also included, which is one of only two events in which men compete against women.

These stamps are official commemoratives issued by the U.S. Postal Service. They're only available for a limited time. So get yours now. Then keep them forever. So you can relive the excitement of the tradition.


