1996 Centennial Olympic Stamps.

Since 1932, the U.S. Postal Service has issued special commemorative Olympic stamps. This year, we've dedicated 20 stamps in honor of international athletic competition.

The 1996 Centennial Olympic stamps were designed by artist Richard Wadrop to capture athletes at the height of performance in twenty Olympic events. The collection includes Beach Volleyball, Women's Soccer and Women's Softball. These events are included in Olympic medal competition for the first time.

Other events featured on the stamps include Men's Cycling, Women's Diving, Men's Canoeing, Decathlon, Men's Shot Put, Women's Judo, Men's Sprinting, Women's Gymnastics, and Men's Swimming. Equestrian is also included, which is one of only two events in which men compete against women.

These stamps are official commemoratives issued by the U.S. Postal Service. They're only available for a limited time. So get yours now. Then keep them forever. So you can relive the excitement of this tradition.



The artist of the 1996 Centennial Olympic Stamps is Richard Wadrop. He is the author of the book "The Art of the Stamp" published by the U.S. Postal Service in 1994.

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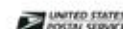
